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| - F1 Powder Frits:
- Flame Opal
- Black Opal
- Orange Opal
- F2 Fine Frits:
- Flame Opal
- Apple Jade Opal
- Light Green Transparent | - F3 Medium Frit:
- Clear
- Other:
- Valcox Heavy
White #0 Grind |
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Non-Glass Materials:

- Metallic Gold Paint Pen
- String or Cord

Placement Order:

Bird Tail and Crest: F1 Black **Bird Beak:** F1 Orange Opal **Berries:** F1 Flame Opal **Bird Body:** F2 Flame Opal **Bow:** F2 Apple Jade Opal
Snow Flocking: Valcox Heavy White
Wreath: F2 Light Green Transparent

Instructions:

Fill the ornament with color frit in the order described. The icicles are clear of any color before filling them and the remainder of the ornament with F3 Clear until full. If using fill weights, this is about 125 grams of frit.

Transfer to a level shelf in the kiln and fire to a **Full Fuse**. Once cool, carefully remove the glass from the mold and add the eye and details to the bird with Gold Paint Pen. Then string up and display!

Tips and References:

General Information for Molds with Posts:

- When preparing the mold with glass separator, make sure to cover every angle, especially if using a spray-on product
- If using a liquid separator such as kiln wash, make sure to give it ample time to dry before adding any frit or other glass
- If using frit, make sure the top of the post is uncovered before firing by brushing away excess glass
- When de-molding, wait until the mold is completely cool, then invert over a soft surface and gently thump it on the back if necessary
- **Never try to pry the glass loose, as this may cause the post to break**
