

Mold: [LF230 Icicle Ballerina Ornament](#)

Frit: COE96

- F2 Fine Frits:

- Ivory Opal
- Champagne Opal
- Chestnut Opal

- F3 Medium Frits:

- Ivory Opal *
- Champagne Opal *
- Clear **

* Optional for backing and adding bulk

** Larger grains or nipped sheet glass work as well

Non-Glass Materials:

- Suitable Glass Separator (ZYP Recommended)
- Metallic Silver Paint Pen
- String or Cord

Placement Order:

Dress: F2/F3 Ivory Opal

Skin: F2/F3 Champagne Opal

Hair: F2 Chestnut Opal

Icicle: F3 Clear (or larger, see above)

Basic Instructions:

Fill the ornament with frit in the order detailed above. Fine frit works well for filling in details while medium frit is good for adding weight. Be sure to keep the icicle free of any stray color. If using nipped sheet glass for the icicle, be careful during placement to avoid removing separator. The fill weight for this mold is about **127 grams of glass in total**.

Transfer the filled mold to a level shelf in the kiln and fire to a **Full Fuse**. Once cool, carefully de-mold the glass and add the details and shine to the eyes, tiara, necklace, and belt with metallic silver paint pen. Then string and display!
